CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A completed ENTRY FORM must be received by the Gallery no later than Friday 30 March 2012, to be eligible for the exhibition. Entry forms must be accompanied by a high resolution digital image (jpeg) of the work.
2. Artists may enter one artwork only, completed during the 12 months preceding the closing date of 30 March 2012.
3. In order to enter, the entrant must indicate some link with Townsville, however tenuous. The link can be the artist, the sitter, some item in the work, etc. This is to capture stories of Townsville and to justify the winning work entering the City of Townsville Art Collection.
4. There is a size restriction. Works must not exceed 1800 x 1500 mm, any orientation, including frame. Diptychs are not encouraged and no triptychs will be accepted.
5. The portrait should be of the head and all or part of the subject and be painted from life. This means that the subject must have had at least one sitting with the artist.
6. All entries must be the original and unaided work of the entrant.
7. The entrant must be 18 years or over at the time of the exhibition.
8. Media: oil, acrylic, watercolour, pastels, charcoal, ink, mixed media.
Not eligible: Sculpture, digital media, photography and textiles.
9. Delivery of artworks entered into Xstrata Percival Portrait Award 2012 will be accepted between 9am and 5pm Tuesday 1 May at the Gallery.
10. Artworks must be dry and suitably framed for handling (a stretched canvas is considered framed). All entries must be ready for display with "D" rings securely attached, 8 - 10cm from top of frame for larger works and 5cm for smaller works.
11. All works must be clearly labelled with a completed DELIVERY NOTE (as attached) on the back of the work, as well as on any packaging the work may be wrapped in.

12. All portrait entries must be delivered no later than 5pm Tuesday 1 May to:

13. All works will be viewed by the judge, not all works may be exhibited. The Gallery reserves the right to select works for exhibition.
14. Artists not selected will be notified when they may collect work.
15. Works selected for the exhibition will be on display at the Perc Tucker Regional Gallery from Friday 4 May until Sunday 1 July 2012 inclusive.
16. Works are hung at the discretion of the Gallery and no discussion will be entered into with the artists.
17. The winner will be announced and the prize awarded at the exhibition opening at Perc Tucker Regional Gallery at 7pm Friday 4 May 2012. The exception is the Ergon Energy People's Choice Award, collated and announced after the exhibition has closed.
18. The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence shall be entered into regarding the decision.
19. Perc Tucker Regional Gallery exercises all due care in exhibiting and handling entries, however works shall at all times remain at the risk of the entrant. Perc Tucker Regional Gallery will not be responsible for loss or damage whatsoever to any work whilst in its custody. Each competitor is responsible for maintaining his/her own insurance coverage.
20. All artworks must be collected from the Gallery between 9am and 5pm Tuesday 3 July 2012.
21. The entrant warrants that he/she owns the intellectual property rights in the entry and that any intellectual property rights and moral rights of a third party have not been infringed. The entrant consents to, and must obtain the consent of the sitter / sitters in the submitted painting, for all marketing, educational and publicity photographic reproduction of the work. Entry of work into the exhibition is taken as the artist's agreement to allow the photographic/digital documentation and reproduction of their work at any time for the purpose of promoting the Xstrata Percival Portrait Award in 2012 and all future years. The Gallery is not liable to pay the artist any fee, royalty or other form of remuneration for this right.
22. Works are to be for sale. The Gallery will sell the work on behalf of the Artist and charge a 30% (inclusive of GST) commission. Payment to the artist will be made at least 30 days after the conclusion of the show less commission payment. The artist must provide a price for his/ her artwork which takes into consideration the Gallery commission and states if the price is inclusive or exclusive of GST.
23. No works are to be removed during the exhibition unless stipulated by the Gallery. The Gallery has the right to remove any works from the exhibition.
24. Arrangements and expenses pertaining to the delivery and collection of entries are the responsibility of the entrant.
