# Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant Pipeline Renewal Works 

Works location: Riverway Drive, Kelso

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering well-maintained infrastructure and efficient transportation systems, with over $\$ 400$ million being invested in roads and transport management, open spaces, water, and wastewater management this financial year.

As part of this commitment, Council is duplicating the Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant pipeline, a key water infrastructure asset essential to Townsville's water supply which provides $85 \%$ of the city's water. The new duplicate pipeline will further enhance Townsville's water security.

Works will include the excavation and installation of pipework near the Ross River Park Booster Pump Station.

Operations will commence Wednesday 6 December and be completed by Friday 22 December, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Normal work hours are from 6am to 5pm Monday to Friday and 6am to 2pm on Saturday. In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.

Residents and businesses in close proximity to the works may experience some temporary construction impacts including:

- Noise
- Warning lights
- Vehicle operating alarms
- Vibration
- Occasional dust
