Reef Assist Environmental Restoration Works

Works location: 11 Barambah Street, Wulguru

Distribution date: Monday, 12 February 2024

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering well-maintained infrastructure and efficient transportation systems, with over \$400 million being invested in roads and transport management, open spaces, water, and wastewater management this financial year.

As part of this commitment, Council is undertaking restoration of creeks within the Wulguru area.

Works will involve the removal and mulching of woody weeds, bank stabilisation, and the installation of erosion control materials.

The **Wulguru Creek** restoration and erosion control works are scheduled to commence from **Monday, 19 February 2024** and are expected to take **eight (8) months** to complete, weather and project conditions permitting.

Normal work hours are from 6am to 6pm Monday to Friday. In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.

Residents and businesses close to the works may experience some temporary construction impacts including:

- Operation of machinery including chainsaws,
- Planting of native vegetation.
- Noise, dust, and flashing lights.
