

Tom Risley worked from the relative isolation of his home in Herberton but his reach was national and international. He continued to make art throughout his long illness and, in close association with Coral Risley, KickArts developed the exhibition, *Last and Recent Works*.

Both in their technical accomplishment and at the culmination of his life's passion, Risley's images of buoys and vessels are a distillation of his quest to infuse his still-life works with the coastal grandeur of remote Cape York Peninsula.

Tom Risley was a compulsive beachcomber and scavenger, and an extraordinary artist. His work has redirected the way we see our natural and built environment as it moves through the cycles of time – the beginnings and ends of things.






Len Cook Artist Statement:

"The Anagama (single chambered) wood burning kiln was first introduced into Japan from China, via Korea in the 5th Century. For many centuries the anagama continued to fire wonderful creativity in Japanese ceramic aesthetics. In the early 17th century the anagama lost their importance and were replaced by nobori-gama (multi chambered climbing kiln).

The Anagama has enjoyed a revival in the last few decades. There are hundreds, possibly thousands of Anagama in Japan. In the west moreover, the anagama kilns are making strong headway and have taken favour with contemporary potters here in Australia.

My kiln is designed around a traditional Anagama. I use Caribbean Pine as fuel and fire to 1340 degrees for 100 hours. Pottery in the chamber is decorated by the fly ash and intense flames. Carbon Trap Shino glazes are also fired in the anagama. Various wood species are used in the side stoke ports to achieve diverse effects on the ware. The kiln can hold up to 250 pieces in one firing."

Lindy Collins has been a practicing artist since 1975 *“when I won a place at an art school in Durban South Africa. I was a printmaker working mostly in etching, which was my major area of study and expertise. I studied under Norah Anson with follow up study in Paris, and went on to teach printmaking, drawing and design for thirty years.”*

Functional Drawings displays Collins' new passion - ceramics. *“Recently I learned to throw pots at the North Queensland Potters' Association Inc. and have fallen in love with the concept of functional art - the ideal marriage between mark making and utility.”*

With an extensive background as a printmaker, it comes as little surprise that Collins is still exploring line. Through these works the artist extends this exploration to line movement on a three dimensional surface. She states *“Marrying the love of printmaking, drawing and functional art making has been a Gestalt moment in art practice for me. Art for Art's sake has always posed a dilemma about the consumption of resources for narcissistic purposes for me as a practicing artist. However the joy of making objects that are aesthetically pleasing and functional fulfils my soul.”*

Collins holds a Diploma of Fine Arts from the Queensland College of Art (1980) and a Bachelor of Visual Arts from JCU 1996. She has exhibited regularly in group exhibitions at Perc Tucker Regional Gallery and Umbrella Studio Contemporary Arts, as well as at GoMA and various contemporary art spaces in Brisbane in the 1980's.



PANIC BUTTON

JAK HENSON

The installation depicts a psychological attempt to control anxiety. A sculptural nervous system hangs bandaged in the centre of the space, while the walls are covered by a series of numbers.

The artist states, *“The bandages are an attempt to protect the nervous system, and the numbers present a visual sense of counting, which at times can limit anxiety.”*

Materials: paper mache, muslin, bandages, wire, projection




