In January 2012 Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011 was introduced governing the keeping of animals in the Townsville City Council. This legislation brought the previous Thuringowa City Council and Townsville City Council kenneling requirements together to form one law for the region.

Council is now actively engaging all owners within the Townsville City Council region to ensure that the relevant approvals are in place in accordance with Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011.

Do you own more than 2 dogs but less than 4?

Yes – you may be required to apply for an approval with council under the local laws.

Do you own more than 4 dogs?

Yes – you are required to apply for an approval for a kennel.

Can I make an enquiry confidentially?

Yes, council wants to help you comply with the law. Call us on 1300 878 001.

What happens if I don't apply?

Any applications not applied for may result in enforcement action.

Can I report other people who keep excess dogs anonymously?

Yes – contact council on 1300 878 001. All complaints received will be investigated.
