## Resurfacing our roads: What you need to know

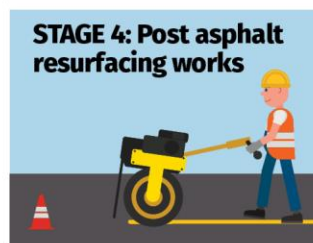
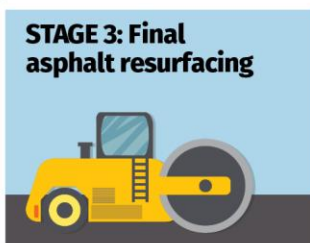


*Did you know that Townsville City Council maintains more than 1,771 km of roads throughout our region?*

Our roads are one of our most critical assets, which is why Council continues to prioritise their maintenance.

These works will ensure Townsville's transport network continues to deliver a high quality experience for users.

### Works will involve:



Council allows a minimum of 7 days for resurfacing works to be completed. Please note these timeframes are dependent on the size of the work area and unforeseen circumstances that may arise.

### Will I have difficulty accessing my property during the works?

- Preparation works  
You will still have access to your property with some minor disruptions.
- Bitumen spraying and Asphalt Overlay  
Access to your property will be limited during working hours as road closures will be necessary. Council crews will always arrange access for emergency services vehicles.

### Where do I park my car during the works?

Vehicles should be parked off the road at all times during the scheduled works. During preparation works, you can park your vehicle within your property. During the bitumen spraying and asphalt overlay, it is recommended that you park your vehicle in a nearby street before 6am on the day the work starts.

### I have a disability and/or care arrangements. How can I arrange access to my mode of transport?

Speak to an onsite crew leader or contact Council on 13 48 10 and the crew leader will contact you to make arrangements.

### I have removalists booked during the works. How do I arrange access to my property?

Speak to an onsite crew leader or contact Council on 13 48 10 and advise of your moving date/s and the crew leader will contact you to make arrangements.

## Resurfacing our roads: Council Works Notification

**Works location:** Moss Court, Aitkenvale

**Flyer delivery date:** Friday, 4 September 2020

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering quality services, updating, and maintaining infrastructure and supporting jobs and has allocated a balanced budget to support our community through one of the toughest periods of our city's history.

This project is funded by the Australian Government Roads to Recover (R2R) program and delivered in partnership with Council.

The R2R program supports the maintenance of the nation's local road infrastructure asset, which facilitates greater access for Australians and improve safety and economic and social outcomes.

Council has commenced the rollout of R2R projects across the city and as a part of this program; your suburb of Aitkenvale will receive the Moss Court – Resurfacing our Roads, asphalt overlay program.

The **Moss Court** asphalt works will be conducted within the residential property boundaries of 1 through to 7 Moss Court and 6 Wakeford Street and are scheduled to commence on **Tuesday, 8 September 2020** and are expected to take **two (2) days** to complete (weather and conditions permitting).

Works may involve:

- temporary traffic control
- partial road closures
- machinery operating on the road – please park vehicles off the road
- noise

On your bin collection day please ensure your bins are out by 6am to be collected.

Normal work hours are **6am to 4pm Monday to Friday** and **6am to 2pm on Saturday**. In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.
