



Townsville City Council and Transport and Main Roads are working together to activate the Picnic Bay Jetty with sustainable light features.

When is this occurring?

The lighting will be installed and activated in November 2020.

Who is running this project?

This is a Sustainable Lighting Trial (LED) project by Townsville City Council.

What is this for?

This installation features new architectural lighting technology to beautify and activate the Picnic Bay Jetty area. It also complements the path light upgrades on the jetty and is being utilised to innovate and appreciate sustainable lighting.

Where will the lighting be?

The lights will subtly enhance the roof of the shade structure and pylons (installed underwater) of the jetty. The lighting has been designed to enhance the architectural lines of the jetty.

How will this affect residents and wildlife?

The lighting will not have a negative impact on people or wildlife in the area. Similar locations where initiatives such as this have been delivered, the lighting has proven to create an attractive environment for fish species during the night. The lights will not impact on pedestrian access to the jetty or marine navigation.
