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Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Subordinate Local Law No. 8 (Unsightly Buildings) 2020*.

2 Purpose and how it is to be achieved

The purpose of this subordinate local law is to prescribe an area of the Council's local government area under *Local Law No.8 (Unsightly Buildings) 2020*.

3 Authorising local law

The making of the provisions in this subordinate local law is authorised by *Local Law No.8 (Unsightly Buildings) 2020* (the **authorising local law**).

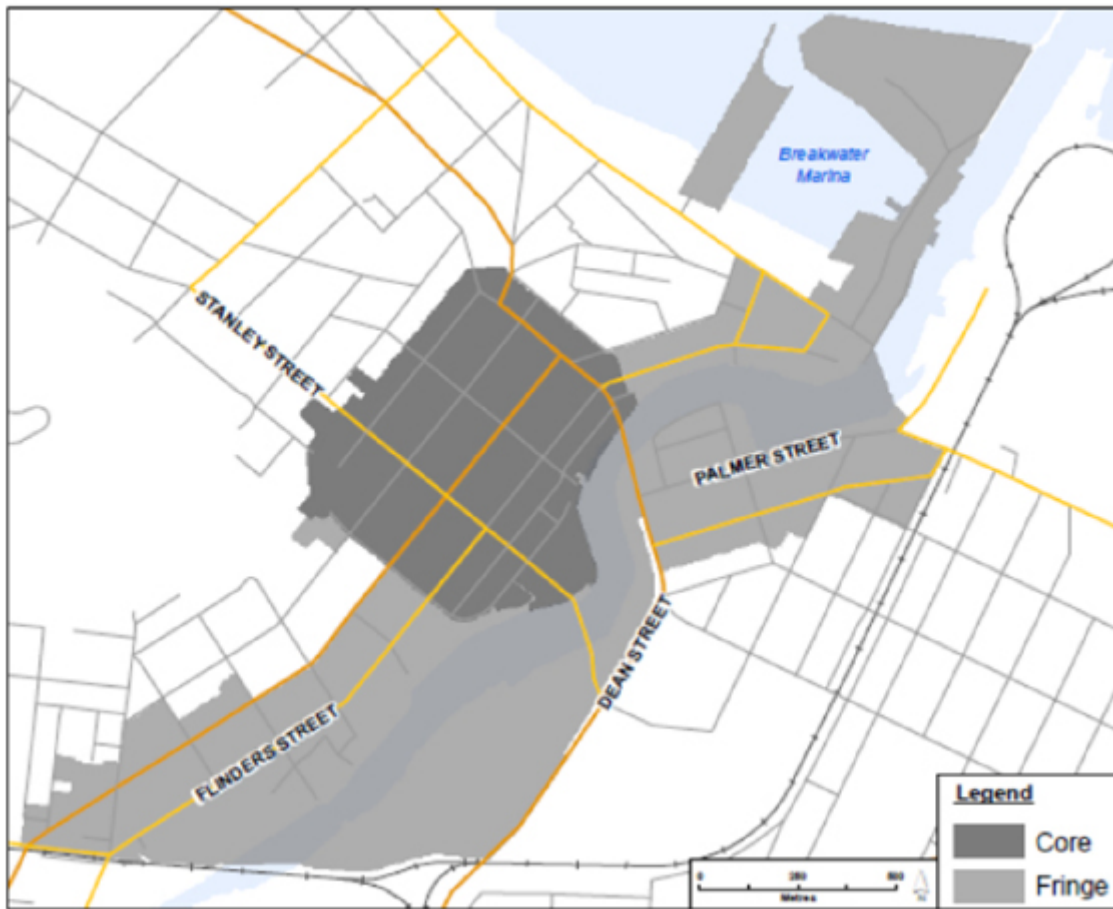
5 Designation of area for Unsightly Buildings provisions
