



# Seeds to Success

**Introduce your students to sustainable gardening, the benefits of native plants and growing local food while reducing food waste with Seeds to Success.**

This new Townsville City Council initiative empowers primary school students to connect with nature through practical learning in native plant growing and kitchen gardens. Six primary school classes will be offered the opportunity to be involved.

**Teachers can apply for one of two garden packages for their class, each valued at over \$3,000.**

This initiative's flexible design allows teachers to choose the package that best suits their class needs, learning goals and delivery capabilities. Both options align with Australian Curriculum Standards.



## Package 1: Kitchen Garden

- leaf Two-year membership to the Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Program
- leaf Access to Kitchen Garden Program resources, materials, online tutorials and workshops
- leaf Raised garden bed flat pack (1m x 1m) and living soil pile (1m<sup>3</sup>)
- leaf Garden starter kit
- leaf Mulch pile (1m<sup>3</sup>)

## Package 2: Native Ecology Garden

- leaf 25 local native plants
- leaf Native Bee Workshop delivered by the Townsville & District Beekeepers Association
- leaf A bee hotel for each student in the participating class
- leaf Raised garden bed flat pack (1m x 1m) and living soil pile (1m<sup>3</sup>)
- leaf Garden starter kit
- leaf Mulch pile (1m<sup>3</sup>)

Activity	Package 1: Kitchen Garden	Package 2: Native Ecology Garden
<b>Term 1: Initial meeting</b>	Council staff will provide a starter resource pack and discuss the nominated planting site.	
<b>Term 2: Introduction session</b>	Teachers will receive the garden starter kit, raised garden bed, living soil and mulch.	
<b>Term 2: Native Bee Workshop</b>	N/A	Townsville & District Beekeepers Association will deliver a workshop on beekeeping at the school on an agreed upon date between April - June.
<b>Term 4: Follow up visit</b>	Council staff will revisit your school to follow up on the progress made and provide guidance as required.
