Murray Street Civil and Utilities Upgrade Update

Wednesday 10 June 2026

What works are coming up?

Townsville City Council is pleased to share that works on the Murray Street Roadworks and Services Upgrade, between Gregory Street and Victoria Street in North Ward, are progressing well, with completion expected by the end of the year.

This project is part of Council's Capital Works program, improving roads, water and wastewater services to support our growing community, now and into the future.

When will the works take place?

Location	Murray Street, North Ward
Timing	Works commenced on Monday 23 March 2026 and are on track for completion by October 2026 , weather permitting.
Hours	6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.

What will the works include?

As part of the works, Council will:

- repair and replace the top layer of the road surface to improve its condition and extend pavement lifespan
- renew and replace existing water and wastewater pipes to improve service reliability and reduce the risk of future disruptions.

What does this mean for me?

If you live near or are travelling through the area you may experience:

- construction activity and vehicle movements
- temporary lane closures and changed traffic conditions
- reduced speed limits and minor delays
- temporary driveway or property access changes where required
- noise during periods of active construction.

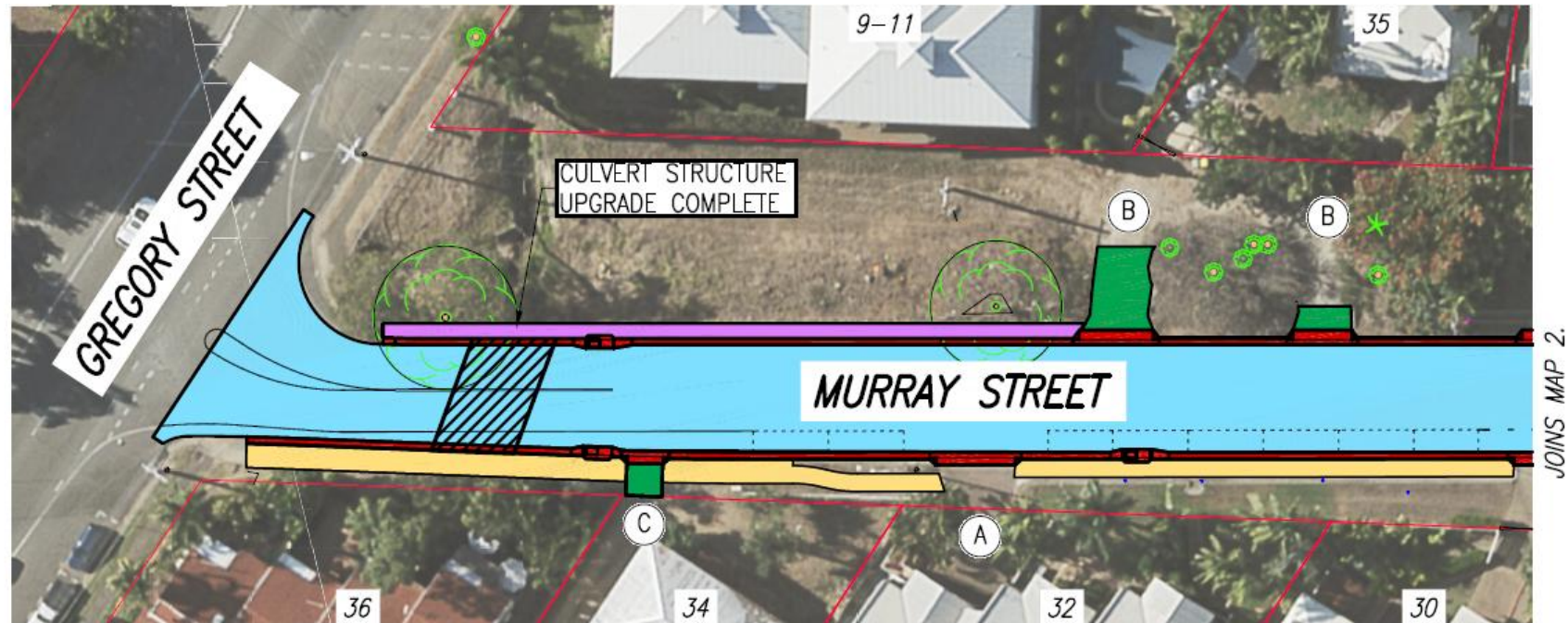

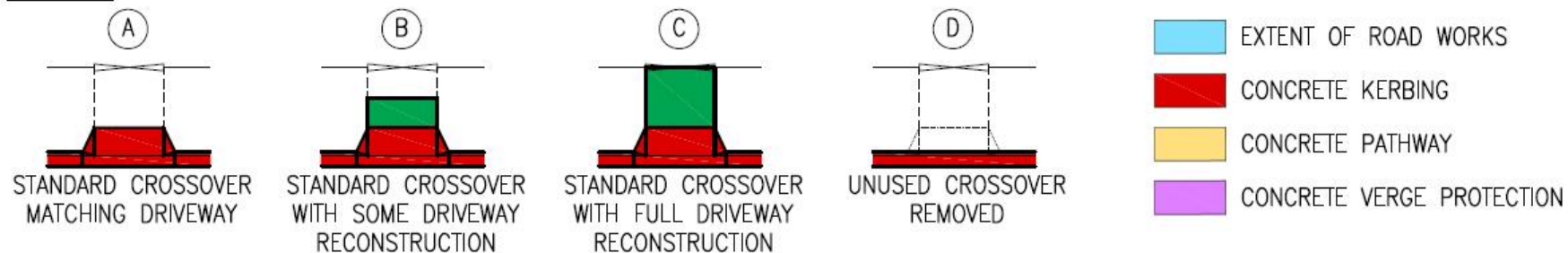

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Map of works location

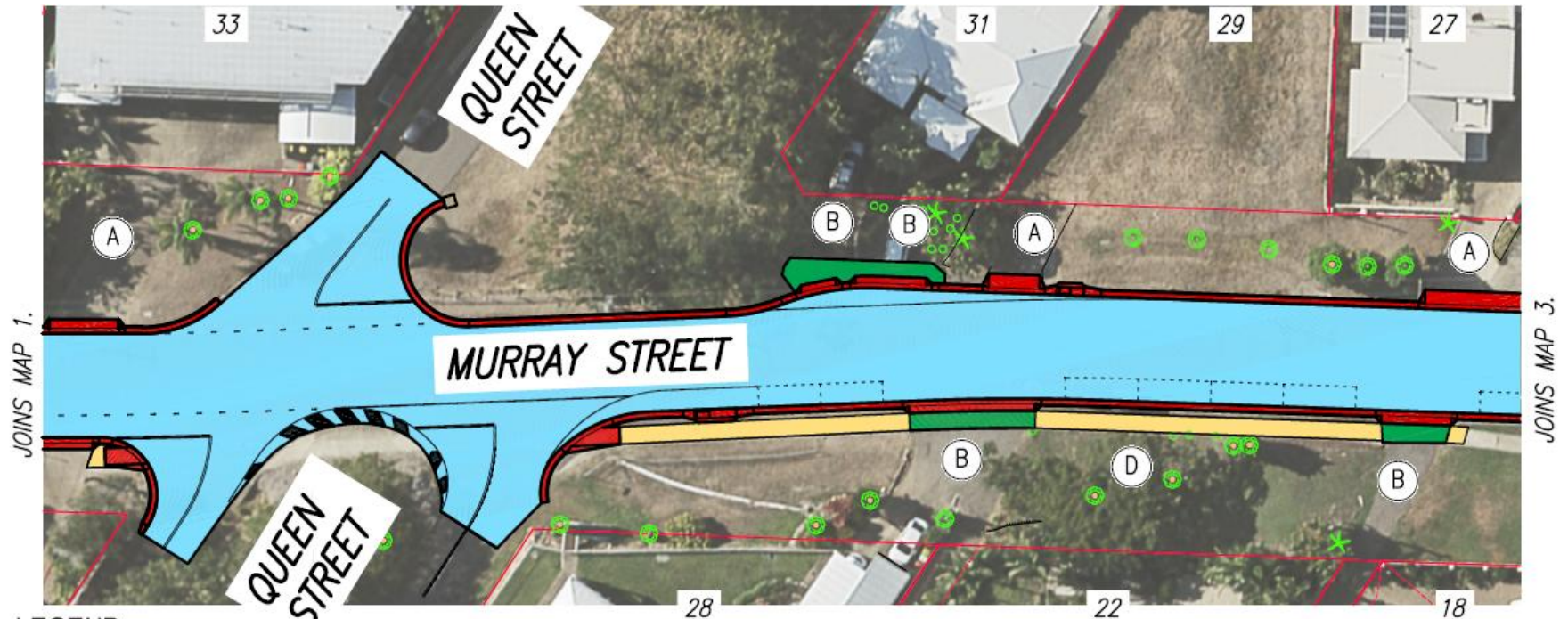


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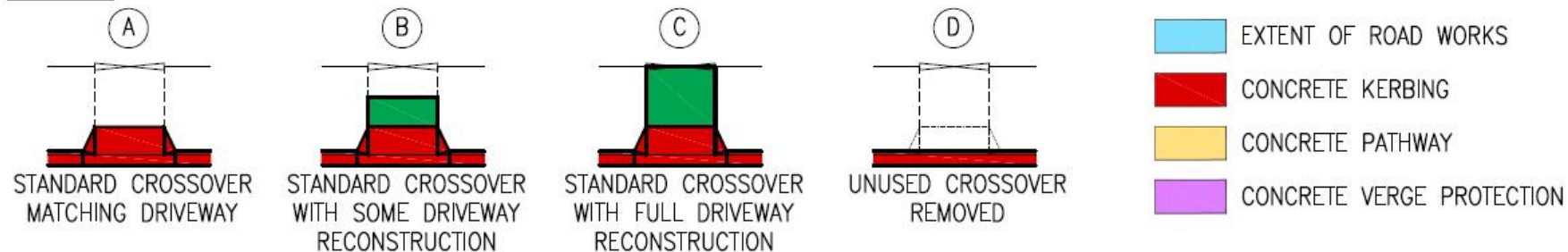


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Map of works location

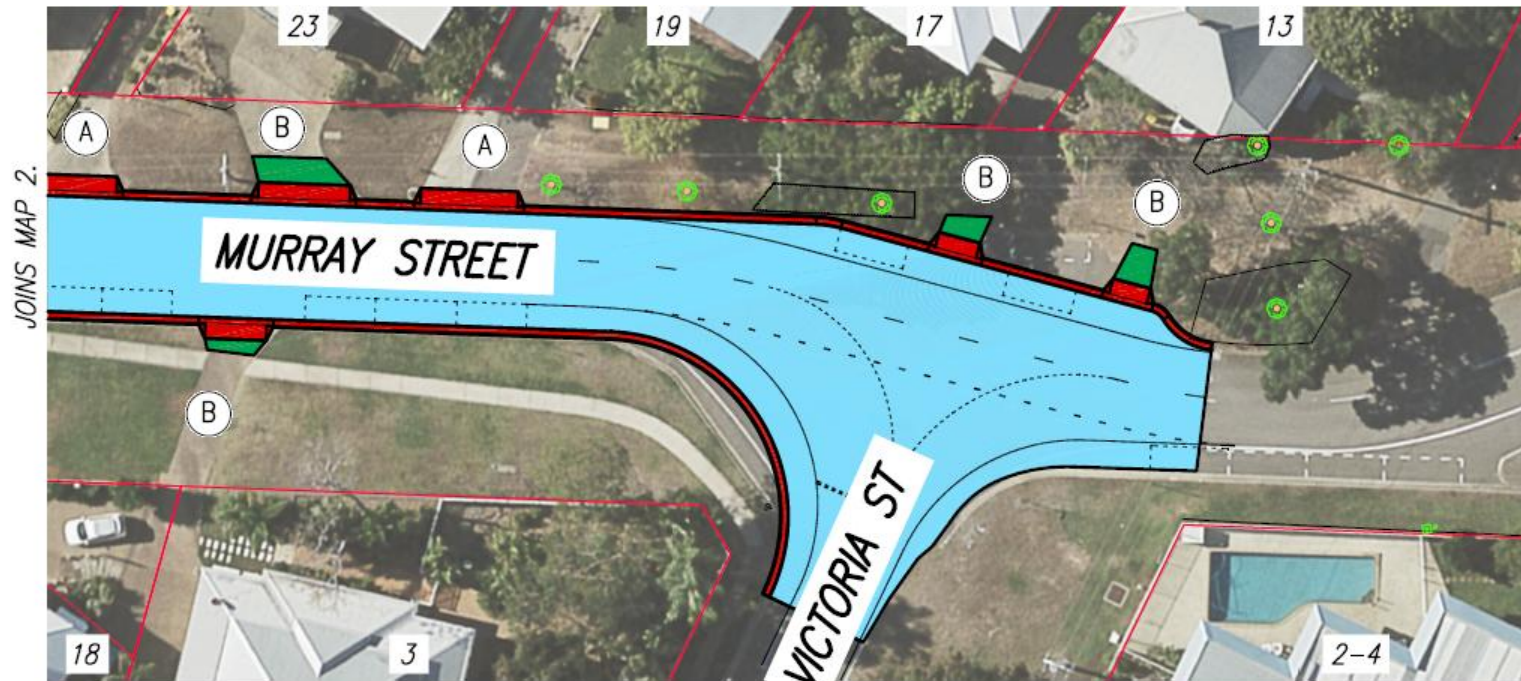
