

EXISTING BUILDING APPLICATIONS – PRIOR TO 2009

Building Act 1975

WHAT ARE 'EXISTING' APPLICATIONS?

'Existing' applications are those that were approved prior to 2009 (usually), and comprise:

- » pre-amalgamation Townsville City Council applications
- » former Concert Consultant Certifiers applications
- » former Thuringowa Building Certifiers (TBC) applications
- » former Thuringowa City Council applications.

For these applications you should continue to telephone Council in the usual way on 13 48 10, and you will be directed to the appropriate Council Officer who can help you with your enquiry.

CHANGING BUILDING CERTIFIERS

If existing applicants wish to change building certifiers, they may do so by lodging a *Form 22: Notice of discontinuance of engagement* with Council's Assets and Hydraulics Unit (find the form on the Department of Housing and Public Works website).

CAN I EXTEND THE ACTIVE DATE OF A BUILDING PERMIT?

Council can only extend building permit completion dates for the 'existing' applications listed above.

Any requests must be made in writing to the Functional Lead, Hydraulics and Building Assessment, at least 14 days before the permit expiry date. Administration fees will apply.
