Black Spot Program

Works location: Shoalmarra Drive, Mount Low

Flyer delivery date: Monday, 27 May 2019

Townsville City Council is committed to ensuring safer roads for our community. Council will be undertaking works to upgrade the intersection at Mount Low Parkway and Shoalmarra Drive.

This project is funded by the Australian Government's Black Spot Program - an Australian Government road safety program, which aims to fix dangerous roads by treating road locations where crashes have previously occurred.

As part of the works, Council will install a roundabout at the site of the intersection, manage property access and realign the pedestrian/cycle path.

A road closure will be in place at the intersection of Shoalmarra Drive and Mount Low Parkway with traffic management in place and a designated detour indicated via the green arrows overleaf through Bonnet Road.

Works will commence from **Tuesday, 28 May and anticipated completion by Thursday, 20 June 2019**, weather permitting.

Works will involve:

- Excavations in the road and footpath
- Asphaltting
- Safety fencing installed for pedestrians and vehicles
- Detours in place minor traffic delays
- Noise.

Normal work hours are **6am to 5pm Monday to Friday** and **6am to 2pm on Saturday**.

In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.
