



Works location: Castle Hill, Townsville City

Townsville City Council has been successful in securing a significant budget to improve Townsville's infrastructure, parks, and venues, as part of the Works for Queensland (W4Q) initiative by the Queensland Government.

Council continues the rollout of W4Q projects across the city and as a part of this program; Townsville City will receive the Castle Hill Summit Track Handrail Replacement works.

Council is undertaking important safety maintenance work on the summit walking track of Castle Hill. The track requires handrail replacement and associated infrastructure works to ensure it is and continues to be safe for community use.

Council advises that due to the nature of these works the Castle Hill road including all walking tracks will require to be temporary closed for the safety of the community and the workers on site.

Residents will be allowed to access their property with the assistance of traffic controllers.

The Castle Hill Summit Track Handrail Replacement works temporary access closure will commence 5am on Monday, 28 November 2022 and is expected to take one (1) day to complete (weather and project conditions permitting).

Works may involve:

- Temporary closure of Castle Hill
- Machinery operating on the road and the air
- Noise, flashing lights and dust

Normal work hours including closure is planned to commence at **5am**. Council advises that all access through to Castle Hill will re-open once it is safe and air support has been completed.

These works are subject to favourable weather conditions and if unachievable works will proceed to the next business day.
