Townsville City Council is pleased to advise construction on the access road, No-Name Road as part of enabling transport infrastructure works for the Lansdown Eco-Industrial Precinct is progressing well.

The next phase of construction will include road pavement installation and will require transportation of materials from the nearby quarry.

As such from the week beginning Tuesday 11 April 2023, residents in close proximity to the worksite may experience an increase in temporary impacts including:

- Construction vehicle movements and frequency
- Construction related noise
- Temporary lane closures and traffic control to direct motorists through the Jones Road worksite.

**Works are expected to take up to three weeks to complete and will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 6 p.m, weather permitting.**
