SORT YOUR LOAD

**Save time, money and the environment.
Sort it, save it.**

Everything has a place at Council's waste facilities to be reused, recycled or recovered.

Many items can be dropped off at no charge for domestic disposal.

By sorting your load before visiting your local waste facility, you can:

- ✓ Drop off recyclable items faster
- ✓ Reduce fees on the remaining waste
- ✓ Help recover valuable resources



These two simple steps can help you save on your next trip to the tip.

STEP 1: SORT YOUR LOAD

Separate these items into groups before you arrive:

- ♻️ Clean cardboard
- 🔩 Metals
- 📺 Electronic waste (up to 20 pieces)
- 🌿 Green waste
- 🛢️ Gas bottles (up to 9kg)
- 💡 Fluorescent light tubes
- 🛢️ Used motor oil (up to 20L)
- 📺 White goods
- 🔋 Car batteries (lead-acid)
- 🗑️ Residual waste

STEP 2: PACK SMART

Following these packing tips will make drop off quick and easy:



Flatten cardboard boxes and remove any plastic or styrofoam



Pack your load in distinct groups for easy offloading



Pack bulky items last, before securing your load

You can sort even further. These additional items also have no-charge drop off points:

- 🧸 Reusable items like toys, appliances and furniture can be rehomed at the Tip Shop
- 📦 Polystyrene
- 🎨 Paint (up to 100L in containers of 20L or less)
