Murray Street Civil and Utilities Upgrade Update

Thursday, 21 August 2025

What works are coming up?

Townsville City Council will commence utility upgrades along Murray Street, beginning with the sewer main near the intersection with Gregory Street, North Ward.

Works will take place within the drainage easement adjacent to the new Murray Street culvert and will not impact on regular traffic flow.

This project is part of our Capital Works program, which aims to maintain Council's assets to ensure the community's transportation, stormwater, water and sewerage needs are adequately met and continue to support the growth of our region.

When will the works take place?

Location	Gregory Street and Murray Street, North Ward
Timing	From Tuesday, 2 September 2025 and are expected to take six (6) weeks to complete, weather and project conditions permitting.
Hours	Normal work hours are from 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday . In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.

What will the works include?

As part of this project, Council will renew and replace existing sewer pipes to improve infrastructure and prevent service disruptions.

What does this mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- construction machinery and vehicle movement
- increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations.
