# **Riverway Drive Water Main Replacement**

4 October 2024

### What works are coming up?

Council is preparing to replace an aging 100 mmdiameter water main along the footpath of the eastern side of Riverway Drive from Allambie Lane to Jennifer Street, Kelso.

This project is part of our annual Capital Works program, which is essential for maintaining Council-controlled assets like the city's water network. We aim to ensure that we meet the community's water supply needs and continue supporting the growth of our region.

Council plans to undertake these works in advance of the Queensland Government's Department of Transport and Main Roads Riverway Drive Stage 2 project.

### When will the works take place?

Location	Riverway Drive, Kelso
Timing	On <b>Tuesday 8 October 2024</b> , Council expects the project to take <b>five (5) months</b> to complete, weather permitting. Council will continue to update the community as these works progress.
Hours	Regular work hours are from 6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday. In exceptional cases, Council may require work outside these hours.

Council is committed to keeping the community informed as this project's delivery progresses. We will continue to provide updates on our progress and any changes to the schedule.

#### Funding

This project is funded by Townsville City Council.

#### What will the works include?

As part of this project, Council will in stages:

- excavate and install a temporary onground poly water pipe to maintain water supply to houses
- excavate and remove the existing aging water main
- construct a new 100mm diameter water main, including new water connections and fire hydrants.

#### What does this mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- occasional loss of water supply from 9am to 3pm. Additional advanced notification will be provided two days prior to the loss of water to your property
- construction machinery and vehicle movement
- increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- temporary traffic changes, including lane closures, minor traffic delays and reduced speed limits.
