Wulguru Wastewater Infrastructure Resilience Program – Stage 1

Wednesday, 11 March 2026

What works are coming up?

Townsville City Council is in the final stages of planning the construction of a new, larger diameter sewer pipe on Wright St, to redirect wastewater from Glenlyon Drive, Powell and Neelsen Streets in Wulguru.

This will increase capacity of the network, reducing both the volume and frequency of wastewater overflows during wet weather events.

- higher levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- temporary traffic changes, including lane closures, reduced speed limits, minor delays, public transport access and on-street parking closures
- Council will notify impacted properties at least seven days before work begins.

When will the works take place?

Location	Wright St, Wulguru
Timing	Beginning in late-March 2026 , Council expects the project to take three (3) months to complete, weather and project conditions permitting.
Hours	Normal work hours are from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday . In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.
