Southern Suburbs Rising Main project



1.0 DESCRIPTION OF WORKS:

The 11.15km pipeline will run mainly in existing drainage and road reserves through Annandale, Idalia and Oonoonba before crossing the Townsville State Development Area to Cleveland Bay.


The design includes:


- 710mm diameter pipeline through Annandale, Murray and Idalia mainly using open trench construction except for some road crossings.
- 900mm diameter pipeline will link to an existing sewer main in Oonoonba. This pipeline will continue, again mainly using open trench construction to Port Access Road.
- A 1000mm pipeline from Port Access Road to Cleveland Bay Eastern Pressure Rising Main.

BUS STOPS

Several bus routes may be affected during works activities across/through roads and intersections (refer diagram)

Generally open trench construction will be utilised during construction except when crossing major roadways and the railway line. Trenchless directional boring methods will be used to reduce surface disruption at these times.

Safety fencing, signage and traffic control will be in place during construction to keep residents and motorists safe.

The project specification requires all sites to be restored to their original condition once construction is completed. It is important to note private structures or enhancements made in council property may not be replaced.

2.0 PROJECT IMPACTS:

Works and project impacts will involve:

- Excavation work (2-4m deep) and vehicle movement will be required along the pipeline route in the drainage and road reserves.
- Fenced work area(s) for the contractor and machinery will be established around the excavation area.

- Large, heavy machinery operating
- Minor noise and dust
- Removal of irrigation, grass, trees and shrubs within the pipeline work area/route (significate trees will try to be kept)
- Changed traffic conditions when excavation work is required near, under or across roads
- Hours of work Monday to Friday 6.30am to 6pm. Saturday 6.30am to 2pm. Night works may be required and will be communicated separately in advance of works commencing.
- Changed traffic conditions when works are required to cross or tunnel beneath roads and intersections. Traffic management will be in place to assist drivers
- Installation of temporary safety fencing and protective barriers adjacent to excavation.
