ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR GRANTING OF APPROVAL:

The Approval holder must:

- Care for the animal in accordance with appropriate and reasonable standards; and
- Keep the animal in enclosures that comply with minimum standards; and
- Comply with standards of hygiene; and
- Ensure the dog/s are registered and kept registered annually with the Townsville city Council; and
- Ensure that the dog/s wears or displays an appropriate identifying tag; and
- Ensure that the dog/s does not cause nuisance, inconvenience or annoyance to others; and
- Take specified action to protect against possible harm to the local environment; and
- Approval is for the person and the property applied for; and
- If Townsville City Council should receive any substantiated complaints, this Approval may be revoked; and
- Approvals are to be renewed every 3 years

Any dogs obtained, purchased or acquired are now required by law to be microchipped. Puppies are required to be microchipped before 12 weeks of age.
