Project Update: Issue no. 3

Townsville City Council continues to improve the existing stormwater drainage flow between Horseshoe Bay Park and the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road and Apjohn Street.

As construction works progress, Council plans to install a culvert across the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road and Apjohn Street.

To ensure the safety of road users, Council contractor, BMD, will construct a temporary sidetrack to detour traffic around these works. Traffic control within this work site will commence on **Tuesday 3 August 2021** and be in effect until the culvert works are complete.

Following community consultation on the new Horseshoe Bay Multipurpose Sport Court, Council has awarded the construction contract to local company, BMD, with the view to deliver the project this financial year. A concept design of the sport court layout will be made available to the public shortly.

Finally, electrical works along Apjohn Street between Horseshoe Bay Road and Corica Crescent are now complete. In consultation with residents, Council will continue working with Ergon to investigate the installation of shields to reduce potential spill light.
