

Council Works Notification (No. 8)

Ross Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant Pipeline Works

Work location: Riverway Drive, Kelso

Flyer delivery date: By 17 November 2022

Townsville City Council is committed to providing and maintaining over \$5.4B worth of community assets consisting of water and wastewater networks, bridges, drainage, roads, waste management and more throughout our city. Council has appointed local construction company Civil Plus Constructions to complete the following important works:

Ross Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant Pipeline Duplication

Council is duplicating the Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant (RRD to DWTP) pipeline, a key water infrastructure asset essential to Townsville's water supply which provides up to 85% of the city's water.

Works will duplicate the existing pipeline. Installing a duplicate pipeline will further enhance Townsville's water security. The duplicate pipeline will cross Ross River near the dam, run parallel to the river through the Mount Stuart Training Area before connecting to the Douglas Water Treatment Plant.

NEW INFORMATION: CONCRETE POUR

An early morning concrete pour will be conducted **5am Saturday 19 November 2022**.

The concrete pour will involve placement of concrete encasement to a section (2 x 10m lengths) of the new pipeline requiring approximately 40 cubic metres of concrete. This activity is anticipated to take several hours.

The extension of contractor work hours is to facilitate completion of concreting and pipe laying work across the Ross River ahead of the approaching wet season.

- Concreting works will commence 5am Saturday 19 November 2022 (weather permitting).

Local amenity impacts may involve pump operation noise, warning lights, vehicle operating alarms and vibration.
