

Council Works Notification

Horseshoe Bay Road Rehabilitation and Guardrails – Stage 3

Works location: Armand Way between Olympus Crescent and Marine Parade, Arcadia

Flyer delivery date: Friday, 30 June 2023

Townsville City Council continues to improve road safety on Magnetic Island.

Council recently upgraded 4km of road from Olympus Crescent in Arcadia to Pacific Drive in Horseshoe Bay. Improvements included approximately 4km of pavement repairs and asphalt resurfacing, installation of approximately 1.6km of new guardrail, new safety signage including vehicle-activated warning signs, pavement marking, some kerb and channel installation, footpath upgrades and minor drainage works.

Council is preparing to undertake a further 540m of road upgrades consisting of pavement sealing and repairs along Armand Way between Olympus Crescent and Marine Parade, and road reconstruction and stormwater upgrades into Hayles Avenue to Cook Road. Improvements will include asphalt repairs and resurfacing, underground stormwater improvements, pavement marking, improved bus stop amenity, kerb and channel installation, and footpath upgrades.

Council will mobilise to site on **Wednesday, 5 July 2023** and expects these works to take **five (5) months** to complete, weather permitting.

Regular work hours are from **6am to 5pm Monday to Friday** and **6am to 2pm on Saturday**. In exceptional cases, Council may require work outside these hours.

During construction, traffic management and lane closures will be in place. Traffic delays are expected - residents and visitors are encouraged to allow for extra travel time.

Works may involve:

- Traffic control and temporary lane closures,
- Operation of machinery throughout the work zone,
- Noise, dust, vibration, and flashing lights.

A local contractor, BMD Constructions, will deliver these works on behalf of Council.

Council will continue to update the Island community as these works progress.

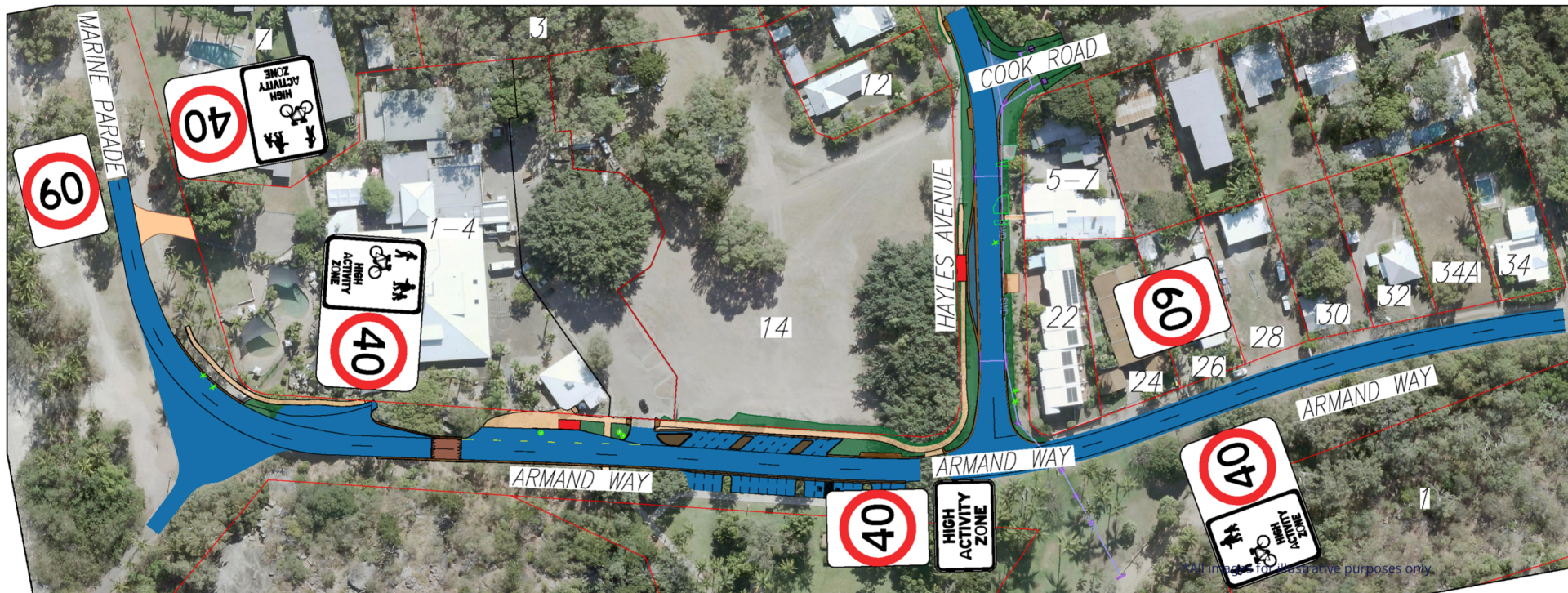
