Cleveland Bay Recycled Water Treatment Facility and Pipeline Works

Works location: Cleveland Bay Recycled Water Treatment Facility

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering well-maintained infrastructure and efficient transportation systems, with over \$400 million being invested in roads and transport management, open spaces, water and wastewater management this financial year.

As part of the Cleveland Bay Recycled Water Treatment Facility works, Council is conducting pipeline construction works at the end of Racecourse Road.

Works will include the replacement of existing outfall pipeline connections.

These works are scheduled to commence on **Tuesday, 7 November 2023** and are expected to take approximately **one (1) night** to complete (weather and project conditions permitting).

Normal work hours are from **6am to 6pm Monday to Sunday**. In this instance, works are required to be undertaken overnight for a period of 6 hours starting at 11pm, Tuesday 7 November 2023 to enable minimal impact on the wastewater network during off-peak usage.

Works may involve:

- Operation of machinery through the work zone,
- Noise, dust, vibration, and flashing lights.

Council has appointed qualified local contractor A. Gabrielli Constructions to undertake these works.
