Apjohn Street Drainage Improvements

Project Update: Issue no. 2

Townsville City Council is improving the existing stormwater drainage flow between Horseshoe Bay Park and the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road and Apjohn Street.

As construction works progress, Council plans to use No. 29 Gifford Street as a storage and lay-down area for construction materials and machinery associated with this project.

Council contractor, BMD, began carting materials from the Nelly Bay ferry terminal to the storage and lay-down area on Monday 17 May 2021.

Transportation of materials will continue for the next two weeks, Monday to Friday from 7pm to 12am. The cartage times are required due to barge availability.

Council is also undertaking electrical works along Apjohn Street between Horseshoe Bay Road and Corica Court.

A rolling single-lane closure within this work site commenced on Monday 17 May 2021 and will be in effect until the electrical works are completed.


