



## URBAN WATER CYCLE

The water we use takes an incredible journey from catchment to tap.

We source drinking water from the Ross River Dam to be treated and cleaned. The journey from dam to tap is no small process, it involves pipes, pumping stations and treatment plants to clean and store the water.

Once used in the home, work or school, water continues its journey to be treated and cleaned again. Used water is sent to a wastewater treatment plant, where it is treated and cleaned before being returned to the natural environment.
