Water craft use on **Black Weir**



Due to high demand, all water ski vessels require a permit to operate on Black Weir.

Users are able to book up to three hours (3 x 1 hour permits) per day for use in Zones A or B. General boating, unpowered vessels and fishing vessels can access all zones and do not require a permit.

Use of uncontrolled water skiing devices, including but not limited to, a toboggan, tube or sea-biscuit are prohibited in all zones, as is free style jet skiing. Jet skis can only be used to tow water skiers.

Vessel numbers are limited for the safety of all river users. To see the list of aquatic events utilising Black Weir, visit townsville.qld.gov.au.
