

## Apjohn Street Drainage Improvements

Project Update: Issue no. 6

Townsville City Council is nearing completion of the stormwater drainage improvements between Horseshoe Bay Park and the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road and Apjohn Street.

BMD commenced asphalt works along Apjohn Street between Horseshoe Bay Road and Corica Crescent this week. Council expects, weather permitting, this portion of the project to take ten (10) days to complete.

As part of these works, there will be periods of manual traffic control along Apjohn Street and at the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road. During this time, Council continues to encourage residents and visitors to plan their trips and allow extra travel time.

Next month, BMD plans to:

- install associated guardrails and handrails
- construct a new section of plain concrete pathway
- line mark the asphalt works, respread topsoil and lay turf where required.

Drainage works will be ongoing throughout next month.

BMD expects onsite works to be complete by May 2022, with any identified defects addressed to achieve practical completion by Thursday, 30 June 2022.
