NECTAR PLANTS FOR OUR TROPICAL BIRD SPECIES



Weeping Bottlebrush

Callistemon viminalis

Flowers in spring-early summer
Grows 6m tall x 4m wide



Honey Gem Grevillea

Grevillea 'Honey Gem'

Flowers in late winter-spring
Grows 5m tall x 4m wide



Little Evodia

Melicope rubra

Flowers in spring-summer
Grows 6m tall x 4m wide



Golden Penda

Xanthostemon chrysanthus

Flowers in summer-autumn-winter
Grows 10m tall x 5m wide

Hinchinbrook Island Bottlebrush

Callistemon 'Hinchinbrook'

Flowers in spring-autumn
Grows 1.5m tall x 2m wide



Mt Blackwood Holly

Graptophyllum ilicifolium

Flowers in spring-early summer
Grows 4m tall x 3m wide



Red Silky Oak (Prostrate Red)

Grevillea banksii 'Ruby Red'

Flowers in winter-spring-summer
Grows 30cm tall x 3m wide



Little Penda

Xanthostemon verticillatus

Flowers winter-spring-summer
Grows 2m tall x 2m wide
