## UPDATE - Palm Tree Removals Picnic Bay Amenities Renewal

Monday, 24 February 2025

### What works are coming up?

Council's Principal Arborist recently conducted a thorough inspection of the Yule Street, Picnic Bay amenities renewal site and identified three Foxtail Palms for removal.

The decision to remove the palms was made based on the certified arborist's report, with safety and the successful completion of the amenities renewal project as a priority.

Council recognises the value of trees and is committed to minimising the impact of their removal by carefully planning replanting and proper placement.

### When will the works take place?

<b>Location</b>	<b>Yule Street, Picnic Bay – Magnetic Island</b>
<b>Timing</b>	<b>Monday, 3 March 2025</b> and is expected to take <b>one (1) day</b> to complete, weather and project conditions permitting.
<b>Hours</b>	Normal work hours are from <b>6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday</b> . In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.

### What will the works include?

As part of this project, Council will:

- remove and mulch three trees
- plant replacement trees near the removed trees to replace the equivalent lost canopy cover.

### Funding

This project is proudly funded by the Queensland Government's Works for Queensland program.

### What does this mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- construction machinery and vehicle movement
- increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- the palm tree removals will be part of the ongoing construction of the new amenities on Yule Street, Picnic Bay.
