Recovery from February 2019 unprecedented monsoon event

Total funding for River Restoration and Coastal Recovery is \$9 million.

Projects:

- **Reconnaissance \$140,700**
 - Environmental Impact Assessment
- **River Restoration \$7.6 million**
 - Goondaloo Creek
 - Ross River (\$5.4 million)
 - Crystal Creek
 - Black River
- **Coastal Recovery \$1.3 million**
 - Rowes Bay (\$735,000)
 - Cungulla
 - Nelly Bay – Magnetic Island
 - Horseshoe Bay – Magnetic Island
 - West Point – Magnetic Island

Environmental Recovery and Resilience objectives of the program:

- Begin restoration of Townsville's waterways and coastal environments damaged during the 2019 monsoon event and improve resilience to future events
- Developing a deeper understanding of how local natural systems respond to disaster events and ways to enhance natural resilience to future disaster events.

Program Scope includes implementation of:

- Debris removal
- Riverbed flow path recovery
- Riverbank stabilisation construction works
- Riverbank revegetation
- Beach erosion recovery and reinstatement of vegetated dunes.
