





Apjohn Street Drainage Improvements

Project Update: Issue no. 4

Townsville City Council continues to improve the existing stormwater drainage flow between Horseshoe Bay Park and the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road and Apjohn Street.

Following the installation of a new drainage culvert across the intersection of Horseshoe Bay Road and Apjohn Street, Council is preparing to backfill the trench dig out with road base. Once backfilled, Council will apply a temporary seal across the disturbed road surface to allow one-way traffic to resume along Horseshoe Bay Road. The current detour along Apjohn Street will remain in place. We anticipate these works to be complete by the end of next week.

Council anticipates construction of the new multi-purpose sport court to begin this week. As part of these works, Council will construct a new hard surface, install new goal nets, posts, fencing, and lighting. Following consultation with the community, the project will also include line-markings for tennis, basketball, netball, and futsal. The construction of the multi-purpose sport court is a Works for Queensland project, delivering jobs for Queensland and funded by the Queensland Government.

In other news, Council plans to construct a section of new kerb and channel along the northern side of Apjohn Street between Horseshoe Bay Road and Corica Crescent. Existing kerb and channel within this portion of the road will also be replaced. As part of these works and in consultation with directly affected residents, Council will construct an associated driveway crossover at each property access point within the new kerb and channel alignment. Further information regarding this project will be shared with residents once a concept design is finalised.
