Murray Street Civil and Utilities Upgrade Update Upgrades

Thursday, 10 July 2025

What works are coming up?

With culvert works now complete, Townsville City Council still plans to undertake roadworks and utility service upgrades along Murray Street, between Gregory and Stokes Streets, North Ward.

However, in the interest of safety, this stage of the project is on pause as Council prioritises slope remediation works along Stanley Street and Castle Hill Road before the next wet season.

We will provide you with more information regarding these emergent works soon.

When will the works take place?

Location	Murray Street, North Ward
Timing	Preliminary works will commence from November 2025. Construction crews may not be on-site full-time while we undertake preliminary works. Roadworks are anticipated to commence from March 2026. Works are expected to take three (3) months to complete, weather permitting.
Hours	Regular work hours are from 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday . In exceptional cases, we may require work outside these hours.

Funding

This project is proudly funded by the Queensland Government's Works for Queensland Program.

What will the works include?

As part of this project, Council will:

- renew and replace existing water and wastewater pipes to improve infrastructure and prevent service disruptions.
- repair and replace the top layer of the road surface to improve its condition and extend its lifespan.

What does this mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- construction machinery and vehicle movement
- increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- temporary traffic changes, including lane closures, minor traffic delays and reduced speed limits.

Roadworks: What you need to know

Did you know Townsville City Council maintains more than 1,842km of roads and more than 3,335km of associated kerb and channel throughout our region?

Maintaining our Council-controlled road network ensures the community's transportation needs are adequately met and continues to support the growth of our region.

You may experience:

use of construction machinery and vehicle movement



increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations



temporary traffic changes, including lane closures, minor traffic delays and reduced speed limits.



Traffic Changes

During construction activities, there may be temporary changes to the traffic flow. Traffic controllers and signs will be in place to guide local traffic. Expect traffic delays and temporary loss of car parking spaces. Council advises residents and visitors to allow extra travel time.

Access to Property

You will have access to your property with minimal disruptions. If temporary access restrictions are necessary, Council will contact you at least 24 hours prior.

Arranging Access

You can arrange access to your property by speaking to an on-site crew leader or by calling Council on **13 48 10** for arrangements.

Parking

Please ensure that your vehicles are always parked within your property or on a nearby street before 6am on the day of construction and off the road during the works.

Irrigation System

Inform an on-site crew leader if there is an irrigation system on the nature strip before work begins. After completing the work, check the system's operation and report any damage within one month.
