HOW WE ARE TRACKING WITH OUR SERVICE EXCELLENCE CHARTER

Last year the Service Excellence Charter was implemented and over the course of the year our performance against the KPIs improved. In this reporting period I'm pleased to inform you that we performed well within our timeframes on 9 out of 10 objectives.

Of particular focus lately has been the timely release of bank guarantees and I'm pleased to report that the number of days beween request and release is 7.5 days, well within our 10 day target, but an increase of 1.5 days from the last report. We are also proud of our result in issuing survey plans - our target is 20 days and in the last reporting period we delivered within 13 days. Whilst this is a great result in itself, we have improved on this by delivering these within 6.5 days.

Commercial Plumbing and Drainage is also performing well. Our target is 15 days and for this period we are not down by 2 days from last year's result, coming in at 3.22 days.

Our compliance assessment applications exceeded our target by 2.29 days. We expect this to occur from time to time due to the diversity in this category. This could be for a number of reasons, such as when extra time is needed to negiotiate mutually exclusive outcomes for an indiviual application.
