The Challenge for all Curious Kids

- The arts allow us to view science and the world in different ways.
- Let's be curious about music and sound waves.
- What music can you make with recyclable materials?
- · Let's be a band.



What do we need?

- Recyclable items like ice cream tubs, water bottles, cardboard, boxes, milk lids, tubes, or experiment with other things you have.
- Rice, rocks, large elastic bands, straws, paper plates, big buttons.
- Pens, paper, scissors, sticky tape, glue.



Explore & Create

- Put rice or/and rocks in a plastic bottle. Shake it.
- Tape different length straws together. Blow in them.
- Glue or tape buttons onto a paper plate. Hit it with your hand.
- Roll up newspaper into two long rolls. Clap them together.
- Place elastic bands over a box. Run your fingers along the bands.



Question to Ask & Words to Use

- What can you hear? What do you see?
- Tell me about your ...? How did you...?
- Loud, soft, high, low, sound, musician, orchestra, instruments.
- Create, try, invent, curious.

- Play your new musical instrument everywhere.
- Join friends and play as a band. What is your band's name?
- Can you create your own song?
- Your band can perform at your next special occasion.
