3 ACAC Advocacy Plan continuation of development

The Meeting Facilitator provided an overview of the ACAC Advocacy Plan continuation of development.

a. The proposed themes with regards to the ACAC Advocacy Plan are as follows:

Arts patronage

- Rebuild audience confidence

Professional pathways

 Townsville Tour Broker concept, Arts Hub, education/student development to support growth (place, space and growth)

Local arts industry development

 Increase funding for the Townsville arts community, regional arts considerations, higher order strategic connections e.g. Arts Queensland, growth phase, collaborative artist community

Increase artist communities' voice and navigation into Council

- Engagement, place-based knowledge

The Meeting Facilitator explained development of the proposed themes were based on discussion from the ACAC March meeting and sought feedback from the Committee members on the themes.

Outlined below are questions which the Committee will progressively work through with regards to the abovementioned themes to build the ACAC advocacy plan

b.

- (i) Build knowledge
 - (a) Whom does this topic affect?
 - (b) What's the scale of this topic (national, state, local, community)?
- (ii) Identify specific problems that need to be addressed
 - (a) What does this topic look like at the moment (current state of play)?
 - (b) Where is there still work to be done?

- (c) What are the outcomes we are looking to achieve?
- (iii) Strategies and approaches
 - (a) Which of the (still work to be done) are opportunities that you feel fit into the scope of the ACAC?
- (iv) Identify our target audience
 - (a) Which agency, government body, organisation, group etc has the authority to make the change and /or provide the funding?
- (v) Identify our local arts industry strengths
 - (a) What unique skills, insights, connections or resources do we have locally that could contribute to achievement of this goal?
 - (b) Who holds the local knowledge on this matter?

The Committee divided into three groups to workshop the themes and commence considerations of the above noted questions.

Representatives from each of the three groups provided feedback on their discussion with regards to the following themes:

- local arts industry development;
- professional pathways; and
- increase artist communities' voice and navigation into Council.
