

Works Notification

Castle Hill Road & Stanley Street Slope Remediation

Thursday, 31 July 2025

What works are coming up?

Townsville City Council recently advised plans to undertake rockfall protection and slope stabilisation remedial works along the Stanley Street cutting and Castle Hill Road.

Council is preparing to commence works on Stanley Street on **Friday 8 August 2025**. This will involve closure of the road at the Stanley Street cutting. A detour map has been included with this notification.

When will the works take place?

Location	Stanley Street cutting and Castle Hill Road, Townsville City
Timing	Council expects to commence Stanley Street works at the 8 August 2025 , with construction activities to take two (2) months to complete.
Hours	Regular work hours are from 7am to 5pm, Monday through Friday . In exceptional cases, Council may require activities outside these hours.

Funding

This project is funded by Townsville City Council.

What will the works include?

As part of these works, Council will:

- remove unstable portions of the slope
- shape the remaining slope to a consistent grade
- install rock dowels, soil nails and rockfall mesh
- apply shotcrete as required.

What does this mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- construction machinery and vehicle movement
- increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- temporary traffic changes, including on-street parking availability, lane and road closures, minor traffic delays and reduced speed limits.
