FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Join Townsville City Council for Townsville Eats, a gathering of gourmet food and drink vendors, market stalls and plenty of entertainment options. Located in the heart of the CBD, this event will provide a one of a kind experience for the local community, with a fresh theme every month.

WHAT IS TOWNSVILLE EATS?

Townsville Eats is a specialised food, drink and entertainment market to be held in the CBD from 5 on the last Friday of every month.

WHERE WILL THIS BE HAPPENING?

Flinders Street, between Denham and Stanley Street.

WHERE CAN I PARK?

A number of free and paid parking options can be accessed throughout the CBD. For the full list visit whatson.townsville.qld.gov.au to view the Townsville Eats parking map.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM TOWNSVILLE EATS?

There are a number of different food and entertainment precincts set up throughout Flinders Street, including:

- **Food:** approximately 30 food trucks and pop-up food stalls, with a different theme every month to tempt your tastebuds. Every month there will be a wide range of food to satisfy everyone – so don't worry, no matter the theme you will still be able to get your familiar favourite dishes!
- **Entertainment:** stages with music, roving entertainment and community performances
- **Open Air Cinema:** each month open air movies are featured, complete with popcorn and intermission music
- **Children's Amusements:** a whole precinct is dedicated to free rides, slides and face painting
- **Markets:** a mix of Townsville's best market stalls are clustered outside Northtown

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS THERE ENOUGH SEATING?

Every month more than 1,000 seats, as well as dining tables, children's benches, bean bags, and bar tables are added to Flinders Street to make sure you can eat, relax, and enjoy.

ARE THERE ANY ATMS ON SITE?

In addition to ATM machines located within the CBD, a mobile ATM provider is located right next to the main Food Precinct.

IS THERE FIRST AID AT THE EVENT?

Yes, a staffed first aid tent is located onsite.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I LOSE ANY PERSONAL ITEMS?

Our first aid tent will also secure any lost items when they are handed in.

CAN I BRING MY DOG?

Townsville Eats is a public space and open to dogs. However, please consider the crowds and noise level before you choose to bring your dog: they must be people friendly and kept on a short leash. Dogs are not allowed in any area covered with artificial turf, including the open air cinema, and not allowed on any furniture.

Assistance animals such as guide dogs are welcome in all areas.

CAN WE HYDRATE AT THE EVENT?

Yes, Flinders Street is populated with water bubblers, and the first aid tent will be serving free iced water on request.

ARE THERE ENOUGH TOILET FACILITIES?

Yes, along with the fixed toilet facilities in Flinders Square and City Lane we provide portable toilets and handwash stations at Stokes Street, Flinders Street, and the Dean Street carpark: just follow the signs.
