
Did you know... there are 3500 species of mosquitoes in the world?

Mosquitoes **distance of travel** from breeding point





Mosquito life cycle

A mosquito is an insect characterised by




- 1. Three body parts
 - a. Head
 - **b.** Thorax
 - c. Abdomen
- **2.** A proboscis (for piercing and sucking)
 - 3. One pair of antennae
 - 4. One pair of wings
 - 5. Three pairs of legs

Mosquitoes have 4 life stages: egg, larvae, pupa and adult

THE ENTIRE LIFE
CYCLE, FROM AN EGG
TO AN ADULT, TAKES
APPROXIMATELY **6-9 DAYS.**

THE ADULT MOSQUITO
CAN LIVE FOR AROUND
2-4 WEEKS AND PRODUCE
MANY HUNDREDS OF EGGS.




THE COUNCIL ONLY TARGETS THE LARVAL STAGE OF THE MOSQUITO.

THIS LARVAL STAGE IS EASIER TO CONTROL AS THEY ARE CONFINED TO KNOWN MOSQUITO BREEDING SITES.

Did you know... only the female mosquito bites!

THE FEMALE MOSQUITO REQUIRES A BLOOD MEAL FOR EGG PRODUCTION.



WETLANDS AND SWAMPS



Did you know...

some mosquitoes don't need water to lay their eggs.

SOME LAY THEIR EGGS IN MOIST SOIL OR IN WATER HOLDING CONTAINERS. IT'S NOT UNTIL IT RAINS OR FLOODS THAT THEY HATCH.

Mosquito borne diseases found in Townsville include

Ross River virus and Barmah Forest virus.

DENGUE AND ZIKA VIRUS ARE BROUGHT INTO TOWNSVILLE EITHER BY INFECTED TRAVELLERS OR INFECTED



Did you know...

mosquito-borne diseases are passed to humans by the bite of an infected mosquito.

IT CANNOT BE PASSED DIRECTLY BETWEEN HUMANS.

IT ONLY TAKES A BITE FROM ONE INFECTED MOSQUITO.

APPLY REPELLENT REGULARLY

SCREEN DOORS AND WINDOWS

USE MOSQUITO COILS AND LANTERNS

COVER UP WITH LOOSE FITTING, LIGHT COLOURED CLOTHING

LIMIT YOUR EXPOSURE DURING PEAK MOSQUITO ACTIVITY TIMES

Control the mosquito and you will control the disease.

Do your weekly yard check.
