

# Works Notification

## UPDATE – Mitchell, Gregory, and Eyre Street Pathway Upgrade

Monday, 8 September 2025

### What works are coming up?

Works are progressing well, with water main replacement along Eyre Street (between McDonald's and the corner of LJ Hooker) and the eastern side of Gregory Street (between The Urban Loft and Queens Nail N Beauty) now complete.

Following a successful test of water pressure, we will begin night works to upgrade this section of pathway, starting along Eyre Street and heading down Gregory Street towards Mitchell Street.

During this time, final water main testing will take place in preparation for connecting to the existing water network.

Additionally, nearing the end of September, we plan to begin works at two crossing points located at the roundabout at Mitchell and Gregory Streets, and between Queens Nail N Beauty, The Seaview Hotel's Bottle Shop and 55 Mitchell Street. For more details, please refer to the illustration provided.

These works will require lane closures managed under traffic control. We will provide further information, including start dates and durations, as they become available.

### When will the works take place?

<b>Location</b>	Eyre Street (between McDonald's and the corner of LJ Hooker) and the eastern side of Gregory Street (between The Urban Loft and Queens Nail N Beauty).
<b>Timing</b>	From <b>Monday 8 September 2025</b> and expected to <b>take three (3) weeks</b> to complete, weather permitting.
<b>Hours</b>	Regular work hours are from <b>6am to 6pm</b> . Night work hours are from <b>6pm to 6am</b> .

### What does this mean for me?

Council assures businesses that access will remain open throughout the project. We will make every effort to minimise disruptions and keep stakeholders updated.

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- construction machinery and vehicle movement
- increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- temporary traffic changes, including lane closures, minor traffic delays and reduced speed limits
- temporary loss of on-street parking and disruption to the outdoor dining areas.

### What will the works include?

As part of the works Council will:

- remove existing pavers
- excavate and prepare paths
- set-up form work for concrete pours
- pour concrete.
