



Haughton Pipeline Duplication Project

JUNE 2019

As part of Townsville City Council's 3-point water security solution, the Haughton Pipeline Duplication Project involves installation of a 36.5km pipeline linking the Burdekin Haughton Water Supply Scheme to the Ross River Dam. The alignment of the second pipeline will, for the most part, follow the existing pipeline from the Haughton Irrigation Channel to the head of Ross River Dam.

Works completed

- 1,750 pipes delivered to site.
- 4 kms pipe installed.
- 10 thrust blocks completed to provide stability to the pipeline when under pressure.
- Ground preparation for pipe installation near completion.
- Enveloper pipes installed across Woodstock Giru Road near Four Mile Creek near completion.
- Underbore and installation of enveloper pipes under Flinders Highway completed.



Upcoming works

- Pipe installation along Hocking Road, Mountview Drive, Cook Road, Tolson Road, Woodstock Giru Road and private property.
- Continued construction of thrust blocks.
- Continued delivery of pipes to site.
- Installation of head control tower on Mountview Drive.

Road impacts (weather and construction conditions permitting)

- Hocking Road closed to through traffic until late July.
- 500m section of Mountview Drive near Gumtree Road under stop/go traffic signals until mid-July.
- Increased truck and vehicle movement.
