## Water Main Construction Works

**Work location:** Stagpole Street, West End

**Flyer delivery date:** Thursday, 13 January 2022

Townsville City Council is committed to providing and maintaining over \$5.4B worth of community assets consisting of water and wastewater networks, bridges, drainage, roads, waste management and more throughout our city. Through this commitment Council has appointed local contractor CivilPlus Construction to conduct the following important works:

### Stagpole Street Water Main Construction Works

Townsville's water network consists of reticulation pipelines, pump stations and major trunk lines that work together to perform an essential infrastructure process that ensures all properties, commercial and industrial businesses receive efficient operational water service.

Works will involve the delivery of a new underground water main, and associated infrastructure constructed throughout the suburban catchment zone of West End that will significantly provide a sustainable water connection through to all businesses and residential properties within the catchment zone.

The **Stagpole Street Water Main** construction works are currently underway and are expected to take five (5) months to complete. These works will require the temporary change in traffic conditions of Stagpole Street to one-way traffic only between the street boundaries of James Street and Echlin and Francis Street commencing **Monday, 17 January 2022** and are expected to be in place for **five (5) weeks** (weather and project conditions permitting).

Works may involve:

- Excavation and machinery operations
- Traffic management including traffic control on-site to assist with local traffic (please refer overleaf regarding traffic flow)
- Safety fencing installed for pedestrians and vehicles
- Noise, flashing lights and dust

Please note Traffic Controllers and speed restrictions will be in place. While every effort will be made to minimise impacts, motorists may experience some short delays. Residents and commuters should drive to the changed traffic conditions and obey all signage for their safety and the safety of the construction workers throughout these important works.

Townsville City Council in partnership with CivilPlus Construction thank you for your patience and understanding whilst these important works are being undertaken.

Normal work hours are **6am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 6am to 6pm on Saturday**. In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.
