MAJOR AMENDMENT 2025 - TOWNSVILLE CITY PLAN



What are places of cultural heritage value?

Cultural heritage continues to be a major contributor to the identity of Townsville and the local community. The City Plan seeks to help individuals and groups identify, conserve, and protect heritage places in Townsville by identifying places of cultural heritage value.

Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value includes a list of the places of cultural heritage significance in Townsville. For a place to be included within Schedule 7, the place must meet certain cultural heritage criteria.

There are approximately 325 places in Townsville that meet one or more of the cultural heritage criteria, and are incorporated into Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value.

Key Changes

Major Amendment 2025 includes changes to Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value as follows:

- Removal of 46 places from Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value for no longer meeting the cultural heritage criteria;
- Adding of 8 places from Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value for meeting the cultural heritage criteria;
- Adopting mapping (for Overlay Maps) that reflect removed and added places to Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value; and
- Broad adjustments across several citations, and specific changes to individual citations within the *Citation of Heritage Place report* which underpins the Schedule 7 - Places of Cultural Heritage Value for the City Plan.
