Tobruk Memorial Baths Redevelopment

Works location: Tobruk Memorial Baths, The Strand

Townsville City Council is committed to supporting maintenance and development of our city's sporting infrastructure.

Council will be undertaking a \$11.3 million Tobruk Memorial Baths redevelopment. The Tobruk Memorial Baths are over 60 years old and are in need of a complete upgrade to ensure the community and our visitors can continue to enjoy the much-appreciated facility. This project will do this local asset great justice by ensuring it is cherished and respected for generations to come.

This exciting redevelopment will include updating all pipework, filters and pumps; replacement of the 50-metre and toddler pool; toilet and shower refurbishment and new shade structures.

Tobruk Memorial Baths works are scheduled to commence on **Monday, 12 August 2019** and are expected to take **7 months** to complete (weather and conditions permitting).

Works will involve:

- Complete closure of Tobruk Memorial Baths
- Operation of machinery and excavation
- Flashing lights and increased construction traffic
- Noise and vibrations

- Northern Beaches Leisure Centre, 7/31 Erskine Place, Burdell.
