The Challenge for all Curious Kids

- Art allows us to view science and the world in different ways.
- Let's be curious about what your world looks like.
- We are imagining, creating and exploring how we view the natural world.
- Let's make a 3D world (diorama) with recyclable and new materials.



What do we need?

- · Recycled cardboard boxes, cardboard, cardboard tubes, rolls
- Painter's tape or masking tape, playdough or plasticine, plastic animals, magazines, leaves, twigs, flowers, shells, grass, rocks (anything natural), feathers, wool, fabric scraps, straws, paper cups, or any craft items you have



Explore & Create

- Imagine, plan and design your world:
 - Think about what your world will look like? What do you want in it?
 - What would like to build? Is it going to be high or low or wide or narrow?
 - · Look outside for some inspiration. If it helps, draw it on paper first
- Create and modify your world: Using the resources available, create your 3D diorama world.



Question to Ask & Words to Use

- What are you creating? What is your world? What have you discovered?
- How would you find out? What else could you do?
- Nature, imagination, creative, viewpoint, unique, artist, sculpture



Show & Share

- Display your world. Show your friends and explain what you have made, how you made it and what you discovered.
- Describe how your world makes you feel. What sounds are in your world?
