

# Council Works Notification

## Landslide Barrier and Earthworks

**Works location:** **Mueller Street, Wulguru**  
(Land parcel behind 36 through to 40 Mueller Street)

**Flyer delivery date:** Thursday, 26 March 2020

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering quality services for our community and has allocated a budget nearing \$400 million to improving our infrastructure.

Council is undertaking remedial landslide management work to a large section of vacant land behind residential properties and adjoining houses of Mueller Street, Wulguru.

Council works will involve the installation of a landslide barrier. A landslide barrier is an engineered barrier built to help mitigate erosion and landslides.

The aim is to reduce the impact of future significant weather events to residents.

The landslide barrier and associated earthworks are scheduled to commence on **Friday, 27 March 2020** and are expected to take **12 weeks** to complete (weather and conditions permitting).

Works may involve:

- operation of machinery
- installation of safety fencing
- noise and dust

Normal work hours are **6am to 4pm Monday to Friday** and **6am to 2pm on Saturday**. In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.
