

3D Colour Contrast

How to!



Follow our step-by-step guide and create your very own 3D Colour
Contrast artwork!

What is provided (for printing at home):

- Line template (at the end of this guide)

What you will need:

- Printer and paper
- Pencil and sharpener
- Object to draw around
- Ruler
- Textas, highlighters or coloured pencils
- Thick black pens
- Wet Wipes (or wash hands!)

Step 1:

Print out the line template that is provided at the end of this 'How to' guide.



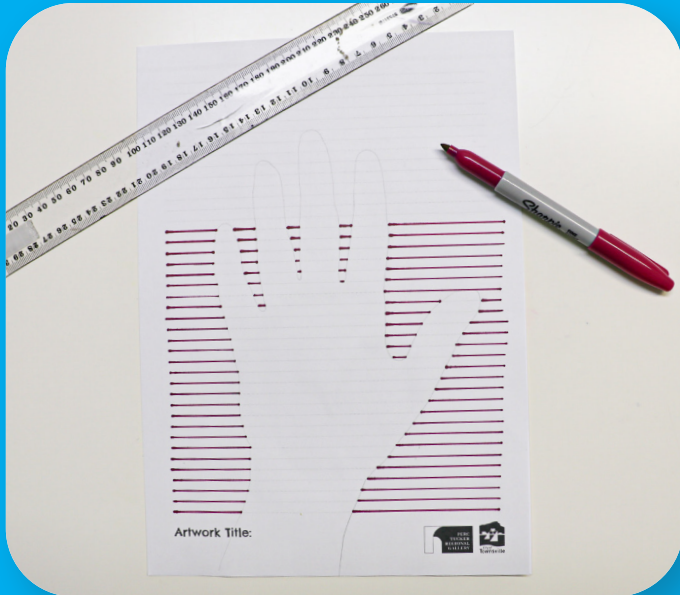
Step 2:

Place the object on the page and use a pencil to draw the outline around the object.



Step 3:

With a texta, trace the horizontal dotted lines around the outline of your object. A ruler will help keep your lines straight!



Step 4:

Starting at the bottom of your object, draw curved lines to connect each horizontal line through your object. Continue all the way to the top!



Step 5:

Colour in the lines of your drawing to add the 3D effect! You can use textas, highlighters, or coloured pencils. Top tip – select only 4 colours for an extra bold effect!



Step 6:

Trace over the first horizontal lines you made in the background with a darker colour. See how it makes the object look even more 3D!



Step 7:

Have a go making another object 3D! Check out some more examples below!
