Playful Paper Clay Pots How to!



Pinch, roll, squeeze, and mould your very own playful paper clay pot!



What you will need:

- Paper clay
- Coloured pens
- Plastic (such as cling wrap or plastic bag)
- Scissors
- A bowl or container to use as a mould

Step 1:

Find a suitable bowl or container that you can use as a mould to create your pot.

Step 2:

Cut some plastic, such as cling wrap, into the shape of the mould. This will line the mould so your paper clay doesn't stick and is easy to take out!







Step 3:

Line the mould by gently pushing the plastic into place. Top Tip - Dampen the bowl first and the plastic will stick in place!



Step 4:

Divide your paper clay into how many colours you would like to have in your pot.



Step 5:

With a coloured pen, dab the paper clay to add colour. Then knead the clay to mix the colour in! Repeat this process until you are happy with the depth of colour.



Step 6:

Using other coloured pens, colour the rest of your paper clay!







Step 7:

Pull off small pieces of paper clay and mould into shapes. You can roll it into a ball, flatten it, or roll it into a tube shape!



Think about what pattern you might like to create and start to place your pieces of paper clay into the bowl!





Step 9:

Slowly work your way up the mould using the different colours and shapes you have created.

Step 10:

Once you have finished your design, leave it for a few hours, or even overnight, to dry.









Step 11:

Once fully dried, remove your pot from the mould by gently lifting the plastic from underneath. Then unwrap and display your masterpiece!
