Nature's Window - Challenge Sheet



The Challenge for all Curious Kids

- Science is looking, describing and experimenting about the world around us.
- · Let's be curious about botany.
- Let's design, create, and share a window from nature.



What do we need?

- · Adhesive rolls (contact), painter's tape
- Collected items from nature i.e. leaves, grass, bark, flowers etc.
- Pens, paper, scissors, sticky tape, glue



Explore & Create

- · Let's go for a nature walk with a trusted adult.
- Explore nature, picking up leaves, flowers and twigs. What is that? Where did you find that? Do you know what this is called?
- Making our nature's window: Using painter's tape, tape a large piece of adhesive paper onto the wall. Pull off the paper so the sticky part is facing you. Stick the nature items on. When you have finished, put another piece of adhesive paper over the nature window (sticky to sticky). Remove from the wall.



Question to Ask & Words to Use

- What do you think you will find outside? Where will you find it?
- What is that? Why are you putting that there?
- Smooth, rough, living, non-living, plants, flowers, leaves, nature, scientist, botanist, big, small, explore, discover



Show & Share

- Give your nature's window a name.
- · Display it and show your friends.
- Talk about what each item is and where you found it.
