22-9 Maritime Museum – Installation of plaque near site of former HMAS Magnetic

The Meeting Facilitator circulated copies of the draft sign from the open space section which included confirmation of the preferred location and an alternative location, both adjacent to the foreshore paved path in Anzac Park towards the old Enterprise House. The Meeting Facilitator noted that the Office of War Graves are yet to be contacted and heritage approval will be required from DES once the content of the sign is finalised.

Robert De Jong advised that the money has to be spent by November 2023.

1 National Trust – Activities in conjunction with 2023 Joint Military Exercise

Ray Holyoak spoke on his proposal of a president walk in conjunction with the 2023 Joint Military Exercise to acknowledge past US presidents visits to Townsville during the World War 2 period. The Meeting Facilitator advised that the event begins 21 July 2023. The Committee members discussed various activities and the use of footpath stickers at Jezzine Barracks.

Ray Holyoak to provide information on the walk and wording for the stickers to the Meeting Facilitator.

Committee Recommendation

It was MOVED by Ray Holyoak, SECONDED by Nick Shailer:

"That the committee recommend footpath signage located in the Jezzine Barracks precinct to acknowledge past US Presidents' visits to Townsville during the World War 2 period.

The signage to be completed in two stages:

Stage 1 – Stickers on the footpath. To be completed prior to commencement of Talisman Sabre in June 2023

Stage 2 – Replacement of stickers with brass plaques."

2 National Trust – Possible restoration of Castling Memorial Fountain, Anzac Park

Ray Holyoak spoke on his proposal for the restoration of Castling Memorial Fountain in Anzac Park. The Committee discussed the history of the fountain and its relocation from its original position in 1926.

The Meeting Facilitator read the recommendation from internal correspondence to Committee members advising against the restoration of the fountain due to the fragile condition of the brittle stonework, plumbing and drainage work that would be required and current drinking guidelines. Nick Shailer suggested the addition of non-working taps to demonstrate the purpose of the monument. The Chair, Councillor Kurt Rehbein asked if the fountain could be evaluated by a stonemason to determine what the restoration would require.

The Meeting Facilitator to provide the reports to Roger MacCallum and investigate the status of the fountain's current condition, including reviewing the previous recommendation and bring information back to the next committee meeting for a decision.
